Handling and Storage

Handling	Sawing, milling and drilling are possible with the tools commonly used for PMMA. Flame polishing and thermoforming should be avoided due to possible cracking or detachment of the hard coating. The product should be at room temperature before processing, or stored for at least 24 hours under normal ambient conditions.
